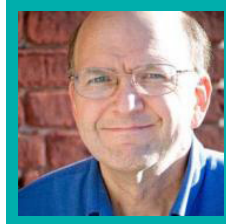


Terri Libenson

Jane Ann Turzillo

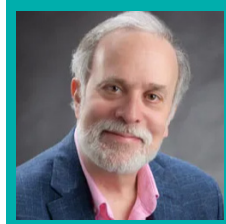
