### Book Bricks: *Painting Pavers*

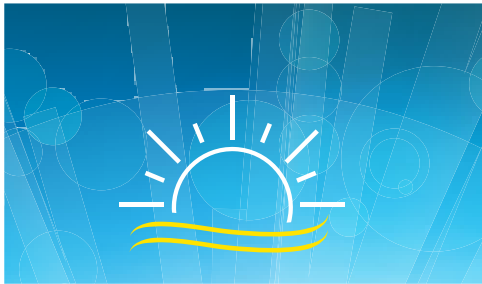
Tuesday, June 21 at 6 PM
