Winter Solstice Story & Craft

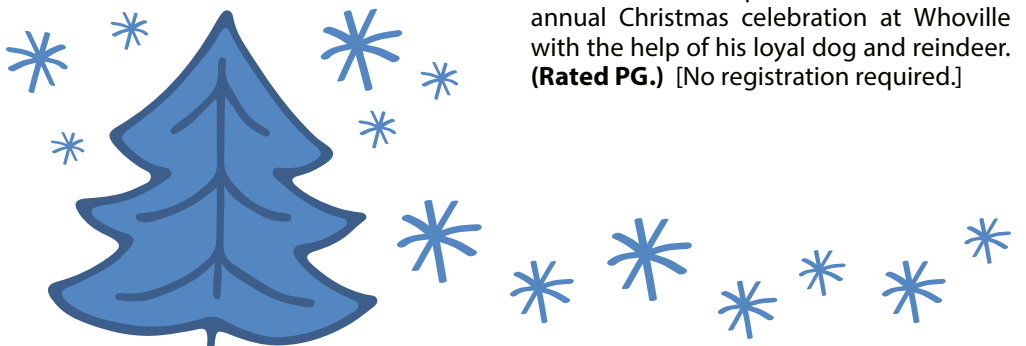
Wednesday, December 21 from 3 to 4 PM
