January's book is **Wicked Saints** by Emily A. Duncan. Registration required.

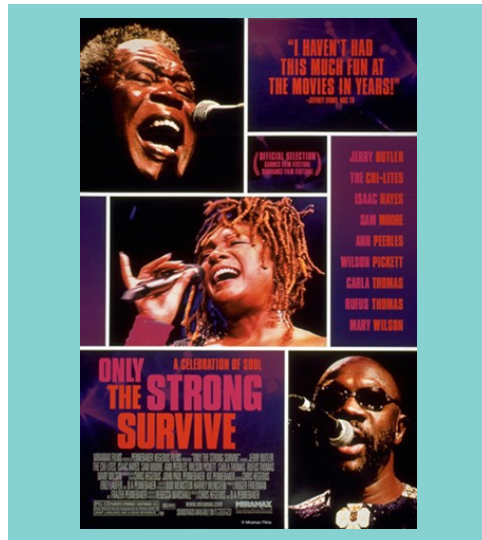
